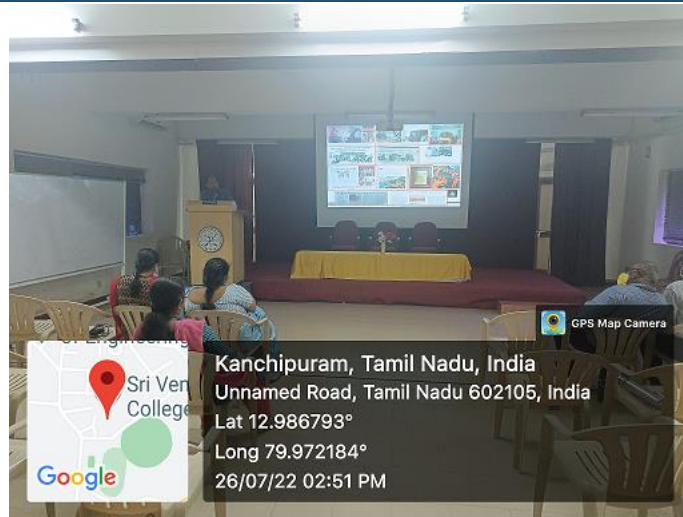
Criterion head highlighted the points in SSR for Criteria-II
