- Student project will be eligible for a maximum grant of Rs.10,000/-.
- Format must be filled carefully.
- The project team (batch) can have up to a maximum of FOUR UG students. A project team should send ONLY ONE proposal.
- It may be noted that the project proposed should be of original, innovative novel and utility. Kindly note that the evaluation of the project is based on these factors.
- The Project mentors are requested to evaluate the project proposals before sending the proposals to Office of Dean (Research).
- The project team should not change the topic and should not deviate from the objectives of the sanctioned project proposal. In the event of any such changes, grant will be treated as cancelled.
- Project proposals received will be reviewed and evaluated by a team of experts. The
 project sanction letter and the money will be sent to the HOD of the department with a
 copy to the project guide.
- The sanctioned projects should be completed and a report should be submitted on or before 30th June 2019.
- Statement of Expenditure (SE) should be signed by the Student, GUIDE, HOD and submitted on or before <u>March 25, 2020</u>.
 Proposals received after the deadline will not be considered and no further communication will be entertained in this regard.
