The Department of Information Technology in association with IIIC conducted a webinar on Cyber Security in COVID-19 on 4th June, 2020. Dr. V.Vidhya, HoD/INT, Students and Faculty members of SVCE and other colleges participated in the webinar. The webinar Coordinator Dr. T. Sukumar, Associate Professor & Asst Head/INT, welcomed all the participants and delivered the introductory speech about the areas of expertise of the speaker Mr. Ravishankar.

Mr Ravishankar started the session with basic terminologies in the field of Cyber Security and extended the session explaining the importance of being e-safe, emphasizing on how to be conscious before accepting the provider's 'Terms and Conditions', and before installing any software. He also demonstrated a couple of virus attacks on a computer and mobile device. The demos clearly showed how an attacker could challenge the owner of the system for a ransom. The examples mentioned were relatable with real world, it was easy for the participants to ingrain the facts and ideas.

Mr Ravishankar threw some light on possible certifications in the field of Cyber Security and their demand in the industry. He mentioned that security is a horizon that spans across all the domains and any interested individual could learn Cyber Security.

The Webinar was more interactive and the participants cleared their doubts during the session. The Question and Answer part of the event was quite extensive where the speaker addressed all the questions posted at him patiently.

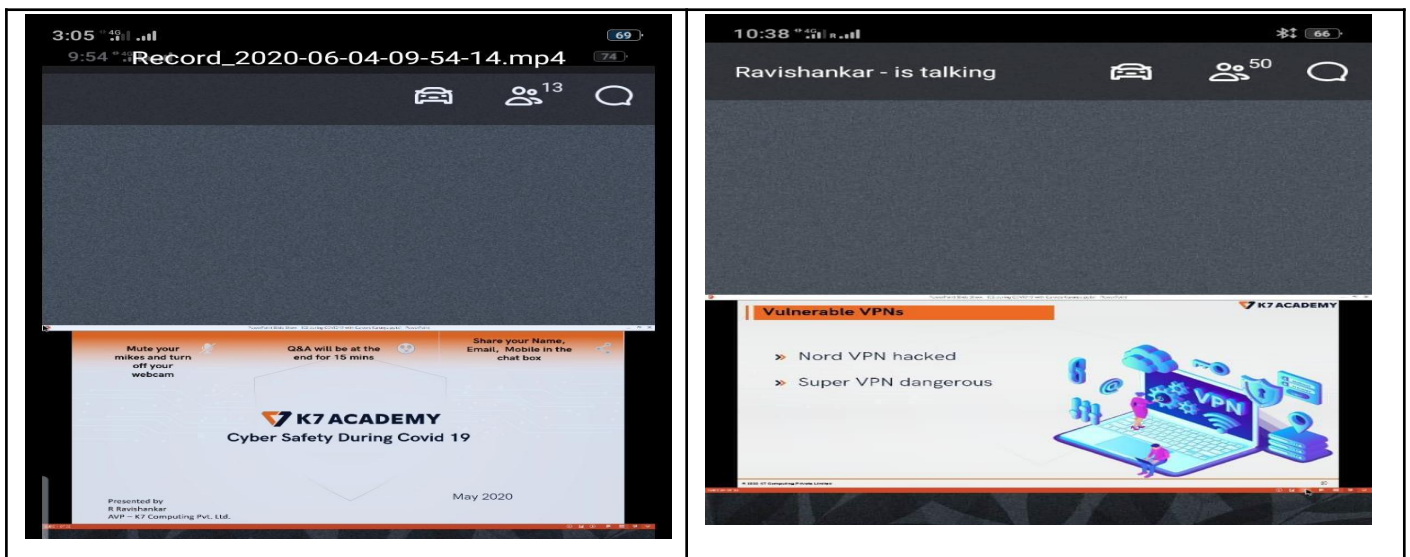
