participants have to bring in their own RC car to race in the track laid by the organiser and the event is timed. A participant has to drive the car on laps and the participant with least time is the winner.

## **CAD MANIAC**

This event tests the design skills of the participants. It is worked on CREO. It is an individual event and it consists of two levels. The first round is an on spot online prelims and the second round is the final round where the student completing the given machine drawing is announced the winner.

## **CRACK IT**

This is a new event conducted this year. This event is similar to treasure hunt, but this is technical treasure hunt. The participants have to find clues to reach the final check point and the clues will be given technically. This event consists of 2 to 3 members in a team

## **SURVIVAL RUN**

The theme of this event is man vs wild. It tests the mental and physical strength of the participants and it is an individual event.

## **RIPOSTE**

This event is similar to an interview. The participant will be questioned technically and the winners are selected based on their communication and their technical knowledge.
