Report on Toilet Facilities

Out of 236 houses that were visited, almost 90% houses do own a toilet. But the remaining do Open Defecation which include women.



Note: Almost 97% of the people who do open defecation were North Indian labourers who work in the nearby MNC's. There are nearly 25 persons in a house but having only one toilet, some of them are do Open Defecation. The Native Villagers who do open defecation were very few.
