Therefore, to create an awareness about the Constitution of India among the faculty members of SVCE this two days FDP was planned Department of Applied Physics and was approved by Principal of SVCE. It is planned to conduct a **Two days Faculty Development Program on, "Constitution of India" during 19th and 20th December 2019**, The communication was sent to the faculty members of various Departments of SVCE.

In his lecture, Mr. Manickam quoted numerous examples from his tenure in Tamil Nadu police about the interpretation of various articles from Constitution of India and CrPC. This lecture was more informative about the Judicial system in the country.

On 20-12-2019, **Mr. K. Rajagopal, BSc, BL**, Senior Advocate & Notary, Kancheepuram delivered a excellent lecture on "**Constitution of India – an overview**". Since he is a senior civil lawyer, he also quoted his experience in the cases handled by him.

After this lecture, **Dr. A. Bhaskaran, HoD – Applied Physics** delivered a lecture about the "**Structure and Functions of Central and State Government (part V and part VI of Constitution)**". In which he has discussed about the powers of President of India, Prime Minister and Cabinet minister in the Central Government and Governors, Chief Minister and cabinet ministers in the State Government.

In the afternoon, **Dr. A. Bhaskaran** delivered another lecture about the, "**Emergency provisions and Temporary provisions in the Constitution (part XVIII and part XXI of Constitution)**" In the lecture, he quoted the examples with how the bills are being passed in the parliament houses.

After this lecture, in the valedictory function **Dr. Pitchandi, Controller of Examinations, SVCE** and also the Chief Guest of the FDP, in his speech he stressed not to discuss any sensitive issues in the classes while teaching this subject to the students.
