

CSI-The Paper Propine 2020 contest will be conducted at the premises of Sri Venkateswara College Of Engineering, *CSI-SVCE student chapter.*


Who would participate?

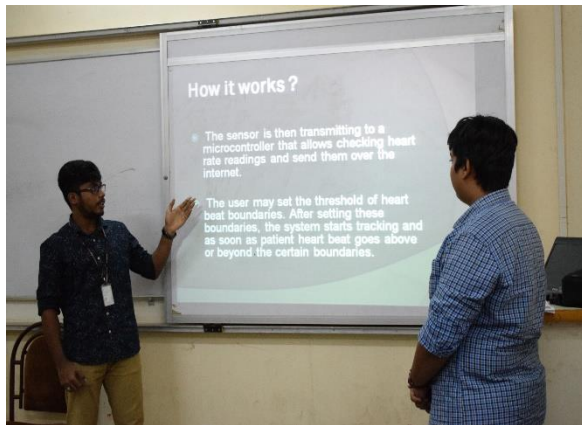



On 13th February, 2020, the Computer Society of India(CSI) – SVCE Student Chapter 2019-2020 successfully organised a paper presentation event named “Paper Propine” which was conducted exclusively for the second and third year students of CSE, IT, ECE and EEE departments.

The session was conducted in two phases, one for the second years and another for the third years. The phase of the Paper Propine event for the second and the third years commenced at 9am for the former and 10.30am for the latter. Around 20 teams from second years and 30 teams from third years had registered and participated enthusiastically in the event.

Each team was judged by a panel of three judges where their ideas and projects were scrutinised. Post the five-minute presentation time allotted for each team, they also had to embrace themselves for the thought-provoking questions that the judges raised about the likely loopholes and vulnerabilities that exist in their model.

The event stretched for the entire day concluding at 3.15am. The event provided the students with a platform to exhibit their ideas in front of the panelists and also gain a wider scope of knowledge and inputs on how they could work on refining their idea and implementing it on a larger scale.

Total No. of Participants: 90 students from CSE, IT, ECE and EEE Departments

Total No. of Panelists: 6 judges across 4 departments



Outcome of the Program:

- Provide an opportunity for students to gain more knowledge about Data Analytics using R
- Allows students to gain awareness about the plethora of projects which can be done with regard to Data Analytics.
- Provide an opportunity for the students to interact with an expert and get a detailed insight and first-hand knowledge into what Data Analytics was all about and what it takes to be a Data Analyst.
