





# THREE DAY NATIONAL LEVEL ENTREPRENEURSHIP AWARENESS CAMP for Information Technology Students

#### A Report

The Three Day National Level Entrepreneurship Awareness Camp for Information Technology Students was organized by Entrepreneurship Promotion and Incubation Center, SVCE in association with Department of Information Technology, sponsored by Department of Science and Technology, Government of India and supported by Entrepreneurship Development Institute of India, Ahmedabad from 20<sup>th</sup> February to 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2020. A total of 83 participants (81 internal and 2 external) participated in the camp.

The camp started on 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2020 with a prayer song rendered by Kaaviya Baskaran, III year IT student. Dr V.Vidhya, HoD /INT addressed the gathering and described the involvement and contributions of the students of the IT department in EPIC-SVCE. She answered the primitive question as to who an entrepreneur is. She pointed out the importance of entrepreneurship. She taught the students how physical appearance or strength does not matter and only an individual's creativity and hard work will distinguish them from the rest of the crowd by using an eagle and a sparrow as an example. Dr.S.Ilaiyavel, Manager, SVCE-EPIC explained the journey of SVCE- EPIC activities and encouraged the students to come forward with ideas and implement them into startups.

The programme was inaugurated by **Shri. R. Shiva Shankar**, Deputy Director, EDII-TN. The chief guest explained the journey of EDII-TN and its success stories. He briefed on the objective of the camp and how its going to benefit the students. He explained the role of young entrepreneurs in the upliftment of the society. The innovative and amazing startup stories shared by him inspired all the students and gave them confidence. **Ms..K. Kiruthika Devi**, Assistant Professor, EDC coordinator delivered the vote of thanks.

#### Day 1 (20-02-2020)

The first session was delivered by **Dr. Nalinkanth V Ghone**, Professor, Department of Chemical Engineering. He created awareness about Intellectual Property Rights. He differentiated between patents, trademark and copyrights in detail. This session helped the students to understand the aspects of every entity and how to apply for them.

The second session was delivered by **Dr.S.Ilayavel**, Manager, SVCE-EPIC. This session touched upon the origin and historical background of entrepreneurship. He illustrated how entrepreneurship often mirrors the Indian values. The students got an idea of the present scenario as he pointed out various innovations that are existing in the market. He insisted that the students must come up with novel and fresh startup ideas to address the hunger and malnutrition epidemic in India. He stressed that the ideas must reflect positively on the society.

The third session was handled by the PG students of RGNIYD. This session was on social entrepreneurship. The students were separated into groups and given a problem to solve within a stipulated time. This made the students to come up with suitable solutions. The session also gave an insight on various groundbreaking ideas and amazing startups which motivated them a lot.

#### Day 2 (21-02-2020)

On the second day, an **Industrial Visit** was organized for the participants to Tyche Payment Solutions. The Vice President of the company, Ms. Malini Shivaji gave the students an introduction about the working of the company and the team members behind it. Following which the head of the Human Resources department gave a brief presentation regarding the history of the company, principles and ideologies on which it was founded.

The company basically provides a secure digital platform for payments while showing ways to increase revenue in online transactions. The students were then given a detailed presentation on online transactions, cyber security, cyber threats and malware attacks and a practical demonstration of a certain kind of credit card fraud. Students were also given safety tips on avoiding the aforementioned threats. On completing this the students were given a tour of the office and information on the various services they provide which include QR solutions, POS solutions, E-Wallet, Payment Gateway,

Invoice Payments, Subscriptions, Financial Inclusion, Edge Service. There was an explanation given on how the workflow of the company was divided among the employees. Towards the end of tour the students were shown cases of the fraud which the company had come across and how they had handled these situations. The students gained valuable insight about running an IT based company from an entrepreneurial point of view from this visit.

#### Day 3 (22-02-2020)

On third day, session was started by **Dr.S.Meenakshi Sundaram**, Deputy Head-IMS. This session was on the topic "Design thinking". The speaker elaborated on different business models available in India. This session shed light on how various innovations make small startup successful and taught the students the importance of creativity in the present competitive market.

The second session was delivered by **Ms.Sowmya Mahadevan**, COO-Exeter (Alumni-Entrepreneur). The speaker elaborated on the necessary qualities of an entrepreneur which are perseverance, confidence and the ability to overcome discomfort. The students were involved in group discussion where various scenarios that comes up when you run a startup were given and told to come up with possible solutions. This made the students think and evaluate the problem like a real entrepreneur and gave them a taste of what it's like to run a startup.

The third session was delivered by **Ms. Malini Shivaji**, Vice President- Tyche Payment Solutions (Alumni- Entrepreneur [B.Tech(IT)- 2013]). This session touched upon "The art of overcoming failures". She shared her journey of establishing her own startup Tyche Payment Solutions. Her story included all the ups and downs she and her team had to face to launch their ideas. This taught the students about team building and how to handle failures with poise. Her story was truly inspiring to the listeners.

The fourth session was handled by **Mr.C.Arjun**, Proprietor, Zenith Enterprises (Alumni-Entrepreneur [B.Tech(IT)- 2017]). This session educated the students about the steps that needs to be taken to establish and run a distinguished startup. The speaker explained how passion, interaction, attention to details and a clear vision can drive a business to greater heights. He also stressed on the importance of physical and mental well being for an entrepreneur.

The fifth session was handled by Mr.B.S.Rajamurugan, Partner, Beard Man(Alumni-Entrepreneur [B.Tech(IT)- 2015]). The speaker's talk involved his seven years of experience in seven

different startups. This session gave an idea of how one can be a successful entrepreneur even if you are a

student and how to change your ideas into a startup. His talk instilled the concept of digital marketing and

online selling.

The last session was handled by Dr.G. Mathiyalagan, HOD-IMS. This session was about

Enterprise Resource Planning(ERP). The students learnt about why ERP is key for a startup and all the

aspects of ERP. The students got a better understanding of how to manage and use resources to get

maximum profit.

Before the end of the programme, few participants came forward and appreciated the efforts

taken for the conduct of the camp. The chief guests awarded the certificates to all the participants. They

expressed that the sessions were very much useful and motivated them to come up with ideas and

implement them into startups.

As a concluding note we express our heartfelt thanks to the Management, Principal and SVCE-

EPIC for their great support for the conduct of the camp.
