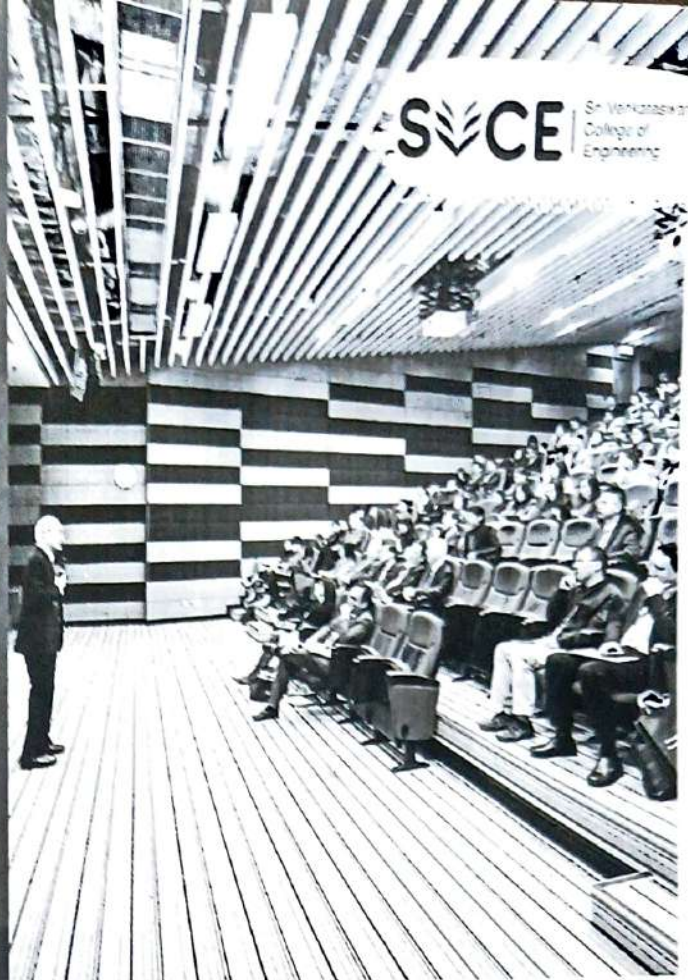

### MODEL PHOEBUS CARTEL - Report

On the 23rd of March 2022, the IEEE SVCE Student Chapter conducted a technical debate-like event titled "Model Phoebus Cartel". The event saw more than 20 teams registering from across departments and years of study. The registered teams were assigned to a company from an industrial domain. Some of the companies given were Kirloskar, Toshiba, ABB, Texas Instruments, Boeing, IBM, Benz etc. The teams were supposed to represent their companies and address the various agendas/problem statements put forth by the moderators as required with emphasis on innovation and collaboration. With the teams all set and the agendas prepared, Model Phoebus Cartel was ready to go on floors.

- The event took place in the Library Seminar Hall located in the A.C.Muthiah Central Library on the SVCE Campus. The event began at 9 AM and the participants were welcomed by Ms. Swetha G M – President, IEEE SVCE Student Chapter. The inauguration was presided by Dr. N. K. Mohanty, Professor – Dept Of Electrical And Electronics Engineering. He addressed the gathering about the objectives of IEEE and provided several insightful details regarding the same. This was followed by a speech by Mrs. S. Anitha, Faculty coordinator, IEEE SVCE Student Chapter. She spoke about the importance of well-defined goals for a student, and how systematic planning and diligence can bear fruits of success in a student's life. After being inspired by the words of wisdom, the participants were all set to begin the event.

The first agenda for the day was "AC-DC". Participants had to transport themselves back to the late 1800s and take a stance representing their company in the AC versus DC debate. The participants had to pick a side and justify why they chose the same with respect to the companies they represent. The participants had to emphasize the advantages the company they represent stand to gain and should also talk about how collaborating with their fellow participants who represent companies that may be like-minded will further strengthen their argument. The teams were given 15 minutes for research and then another 20 minutes to discuss among themselves and collaborate with other teams. After this time, the moderators will listen to the teams who'll explain their stance and will then question the participants regarding the same. The first agenda was moderated by Ms. Swetha G M – President, IEEE SB, Mr. Adithyan M – Joint Secretary, IEEE SB, and Mr. Dhruv S – Treasurer, IEEE SB. The teams actively participated and interacted with the moderators and explained their stances with clarity and conviction. After the end of this



session, the teams were scored based on their creativity, clarity, historical relevance, and presentation skills.

After a short break, the participants were all set to take on the second agenda for the day which was "Revisiting Watergate". Participants had to represent their companies and stop an impending political catastrophe by preventing the wiretapping of phones. The teams should come up with a solution to detect and prevent the tapping of phones and propose alternate solutions for the same. Just like the previous round, teams were given 15 minutes for research and another 20 minutes for discussion. After this time period, the teams were asked to present their solution to the moderation who consisted of Mr. Adithyan M – Joint Secretary, IEEE SB, Mr. Dhruv S – Treasurer, IEEE SB, and Mr. Deepak H – Executive Member, IEEE SB. The teams eloquently presented their solutions to the panel and were questioned about the same in detail. After the end of the session, marks were awarded to the teams based on their creativity, clarity, analytical thinking, and presentation skills.

After the end of the two agendas, the teams' scores from each agenda were added and they were ranked cumulatively based on their performance. The top 10 teams from this list were advanced to the final agenda of the event. The final agenda was presented in the format of two mini problem statements, one pondering the shortage of silicon chips and the other seeking solutions to replace existing systems and processes in various industries with renewable and ecologically viable ones. The 10 teams were given only 15 mins in total to research and discuss their talking points with respect to the agenda given. The teams were also asked to write down the key points of their discussion and submit them to the moderation panel. Once the time was up, the teams were asked to propose their thoughts and ideas about the two problem statements in a concise manner within a minute's time to the panel (which consisted of the same people from the previous agenda). After all 10 teams were done with their minute's speech, they were marked based on their innovation, understanding, clarity, and communication skills.

After scoring the teams and tallying the overall scores with a lot of deliberation, the winners of the Model Phoebus Cartel were decided. After this was the valedictory function where the top two teams were announced, which was Texas Instruments(Yuvakishore, Vignesh from EEE III year)and Toshiba(Akshara from BT II year, Sanjaiy from CE IV year), and the overall best speaker was awarded to Gaurav-PG Mechatronics. The winners were awarded a memento, certificate, and a cash prize of Rs.1000.

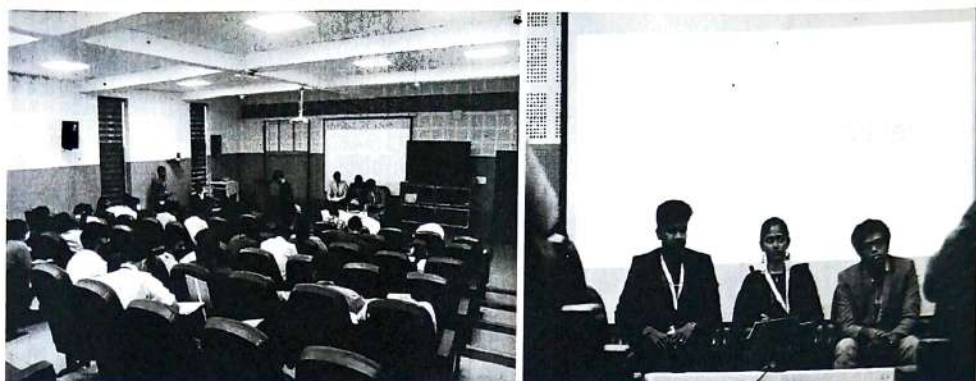
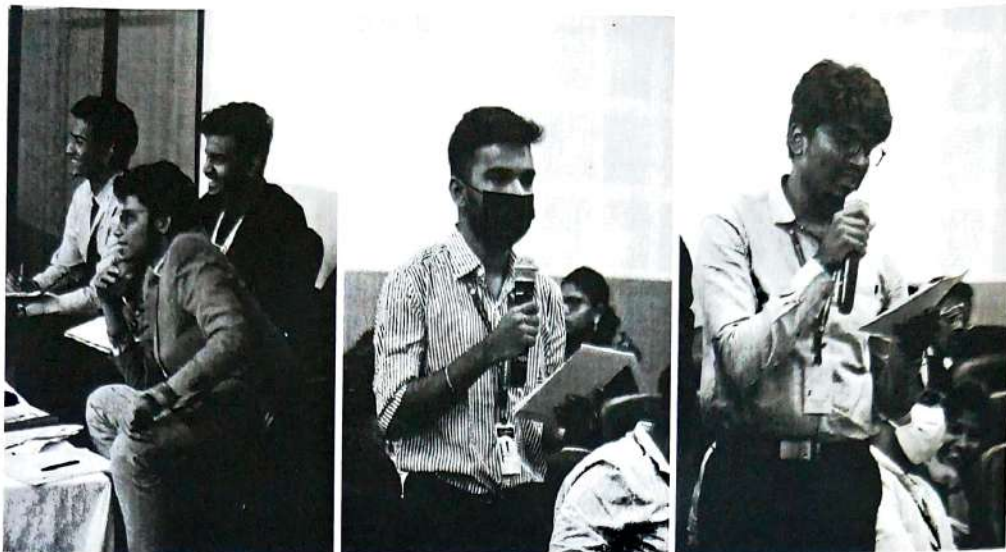


