### CIRCULAR

Sub: End Semester examinations - Procedure for applying Revaluation of answer script for the theory papers under regulation 2018

\*\*\*\*\*

1. All students are eligible to apply for revaluation **ONLY FOR THEORY PAPERS OF May - 2021 – End semester Examinations**, irrespective of grades secured. The scripts mentioned in the serial no 7 are only eligible for applying revaluation
2. Students can not apply for revaluation/review for practical, project, comprehension, seminar and value added courses.
3. The students can apply for revaluation by paying **Rs. 500/- per subject, towards revaluation** fee from 23/12/2021 to 26/12/2021 2021. Only in these four days, the students will be permitted to apply for the revaluation through ERP.
4. Even after the revaluation, if the student is still not satisfied with the result, he/she can opt for a review of his/her answer script by paying the prescribed fee. The review procedure will be intimated along with the revaluation result.
5. The students can apply the revaluation through their student's login into our CMS. The required amount also to be paid through our CMS.
6. At any cost, the dates for applying the revaluation will not be extended.
7. This circular is meant for the following scripts;
  - a. 2018-2022 UG students – 20-21 Even semester theory papers of I and II semesters.
  - b. 2019-2023 UG students – 20-21 Even semester theory papers of I and II semesters.
  - c. 2020-2024 UG students – 20-21 Even semester theory papers of I and II semesters.
  - d. 2020-2022 PG students – 20-21 Even semester theory papers of I and II semesters.
