

REPORT

'Students Research Day 2019' which has now become an annual event, was held on the 22 March 2019 (Friday) and was inaugurated in the Function hall at 10.00 AM. The event held under the name "SVCE' INNOVATES 2019, seeks to channelize the creative ideas of the students and their faculty mentors in to viable projects which would enhance the research output of the college and the knowledge base of the students and the mentors.

The event was organized by Dr.R.Muthucumaraswamy, Dean (Research) and the UG members of the student council. Additionally they were supported by the research coordinators (faculty) from each department. The initial circular, inviting the UG and PG students of the various departments of the college to submit their abstracts was released on the 5th February 2018. Students were allowed to group themselves in to batches of 2 to 4 students per batch and were to be mentored by a faculty member. The response from the students was very enthusiastic in spite of the tight academic schedule. Around 26 abstracts from our department were submitted. Around 64 students participated in the research competition
