REPORT ON MAKE-A-THON 3.0



Make-a-thon 3.0 was a 24-Hour event which challenged students to offer innovative solutions in the form simulations and prototypes which will help address crucial real time problems in our country and around the world. The event happened for 24 hours from 25th March 10AM to 26th March 2022 10 AM at the Placement Cell, SVCE. The event witnessed a participation of a total of 22 teams. The developers had to build products that would impact and shape the future.

Ms. R.Kousalya, Assistant Professor, Department of ECE explained the rules and the scoring rubric to the participants. The Make-a-thon 3.0 began at 10.00 AM shortly after the inauguration.

A THE EVENT:

event commenced at 10.00 AM on 25th March (Friday). The participants were given a few minutes to ach their ideas, themes, and technologies they would be using. The innovations of the teams spanned across a variety of themes such as smart communication, rural development, pandemic safety, healthcare, cyber security, IoT and many more. A total of 22 teams were shortlisted based on their statement of interest regarding the Make-a-thon and their chosen domain.

The students were given the liberty to choose their own problem statements for the event. The preliminary selection was done by student mentors Mr. Prassanna Rangan, I Year M. E, and Mr M. Kishore, III Year ECE based on creativity, originality and feasibility. A plethora of problem statements were chosen ranging from the following:

During the entire organizing of the event, the executive members of ECE Association, IETE – SF and RAIC periodically checked upon all the teams and the progress of their model to ensure and provide if any help was needed. The 22 teams pushed themselves into innovating new models and solutions for their problem statements. Food and refreshments were also provided for the participants. The event had two round of judging and ended at 10:00 AM on 26th March 2022 (Saturday).

The judging began soon after. All the teams were segregated to accommodate the judges who were industrial professionals and professors. Each team was given a time slot during which they had to explain the problem statement and their solution along with a working model followed by an inquisitive Q&A session by the judges.

ABOUT THE JUDGES:

The Make-a-thon consisted of two rounds of judging. The first round of judging began at 9:00 PM on 25th March 2022. The teams were segregated into three different panels. The faculty judges present for the three rounds of judging were Dr.T. Annamalai, Assistant Professor, Department of EEE; Dr.B. Ashvanth, Assistant Professor, Department of ECE; Mr.P.Arul, Assistant Professor, Department of ECE; Ms.T.J.Jeyaprabha, Associate Professor, Department of ECE; Ms.R.Kousalya, Assistant Professor, Department of ECE; Ms.A.Indhumathi, Assistant Professor, Department of IT; Ms.B.Sarala, Assistant Professor, Department of ECE. The judges of the preliminary phase examined the work of the participants and made sure their work is abided by the rules and regulations of the event and noted down the progress and also gave suggestions for improvement.

The second round of judging began shortly after the event was over. There were six judges present for the second round of judging on 26th March 2022 at 10.30 AM to evaluate the performance of the participants. The judges were content with the models and solutions presented and raised questions and comments for






SNAPSHOTS OF PRIZE DISTRIBUTION CEREMONY
