

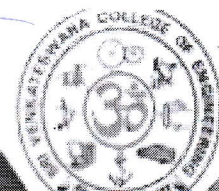

Objectives :

- To enable the students to understand industry level product development and develop essential technical skills to meet industry standards.
- To gain essential professional skills and use it in a competitive environment.

About the Programme:

The Department of Information Technology in association with Computer Society of India - SVCE Student Chapter and in partnership with Mr Cooper India hosted an inter college 24-hour industry associated hackathon, HackIT on 12th May 2022. HackIT received attention from various participants across the institutions. The event constitutes of a dedicated website and was publicized in various social media platforms. Several participants showed their interest by registering their team members and name. HackIT received 24 team registrations, each team consisting of 1 to 6 members in a team. A total of 74 participants from 17 teams were qualified for the event after carefully scrutinizing the teams. The participants consisted of 24 CSI members.
