
EVENT-5

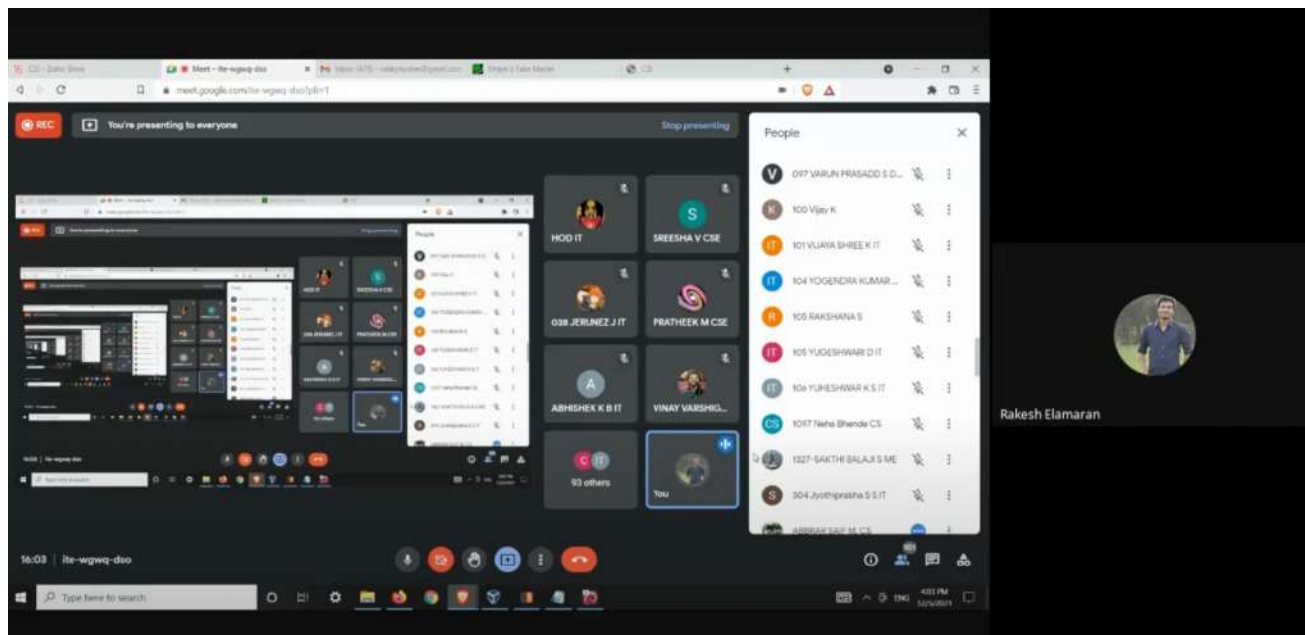

- ❖ **Caution:** Don't try to do both but Be aware of the other Side .

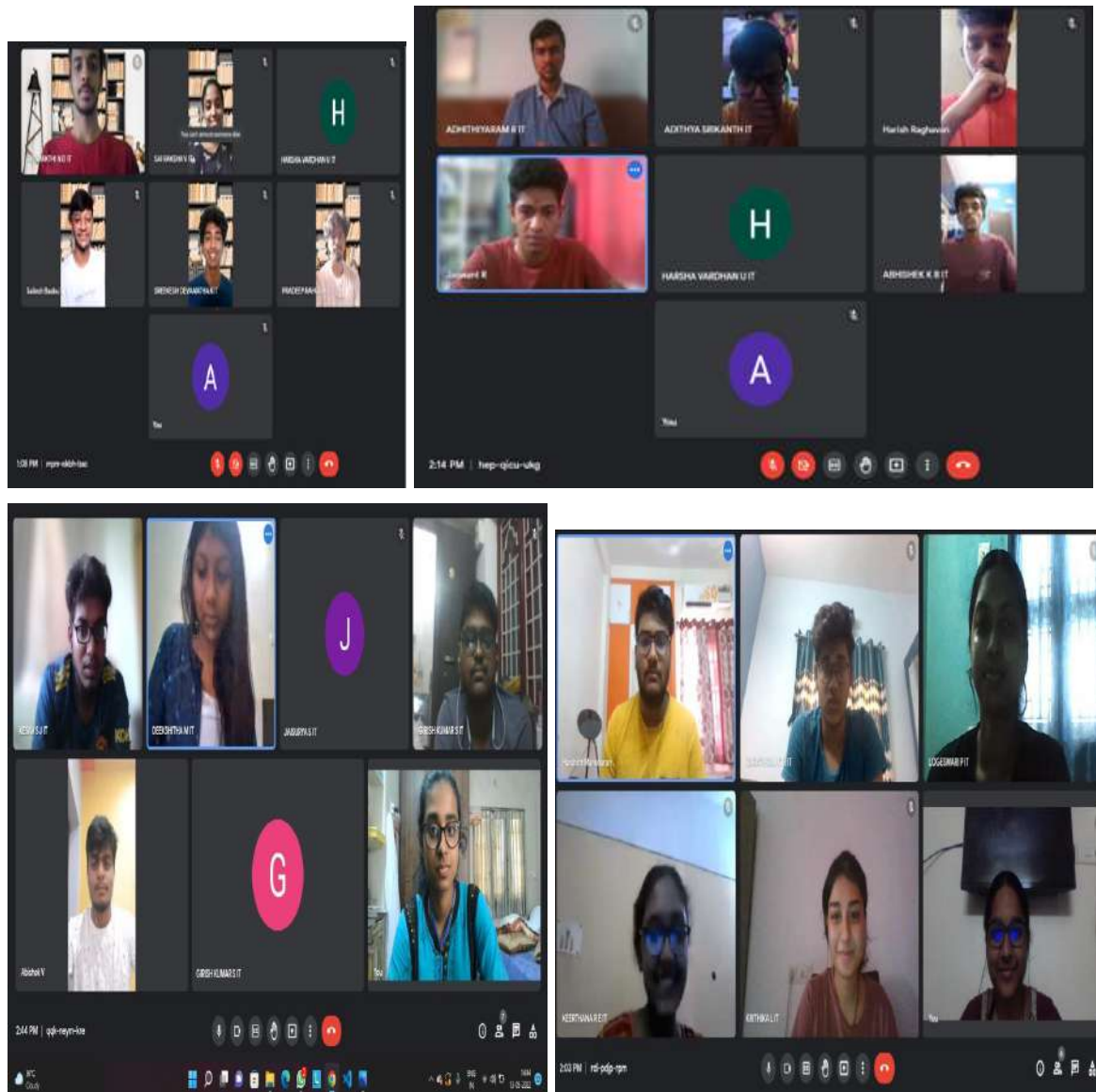
