1. Inauguration of ECE Association & IETE Students Forum (ISF) for the academic year 2019-20 at SVCE on 24/07/2019 (Wednesday) between 10-11.30 AM. Dr.Sathiesh kumar, Assistant Professor inaugurated and delivered a guest lecture titled "Recent Applications of machine learning". ECE Association and IETE Student representatives were elected and given batches on the same day.
2. ECEA along with SVCE-ISF organized a technical talk on “Wireless Communication – A Glimpse on its hyper growth in Telecom Industry” under the banner of IETE Chennai Centre on July 26, 2019. A technical talk was delivered by Shri. A. Sadagopan, F-IETE, Retd.AGM, BSNL Chennai, attended by about 60 students from ECE Dept. including faculty members.
