

DRESS CODE FOR STUDENTS

Students are expected to follow a dress code during the working hours conforming to the general serene atmosphere on the campus. Marine Engineering students have uniform, and all other students are to follow the given instructions regarding the dress code.

Students not in the proper dress code during the working hours will not be allowed to enter the college campus and will not be entertained for any reason.

1. Body-fit clothing (tight pants, leggings, jeggings, etc.), transparent or revealing or gaudy-coloured outfits are not allowed.
2. **Boys** are allowed to wear only formal shirts (either half or full sleeves) and pants. Pants with elastic bottom and faded/torn shirts, pants or jeans are not allowed.
3. **For Girls**, Salwar kameez with V shaped dupatta, Jeans with long Kurtis and stole, Churidar with the shawl are allowed. Palazzo and baggy pants are not allowed. Sleeveless tops are not allowed.
4. Only full pants are allowed. Half and 3/4th kind of pants and pants with torn edges are not allowed. Low waist pants are not allowed.
5. T shirts and Shirts with Chinese collar are not allowed.
6. Shirts with message/slogans are not allowed. Black shirts should be avoided.
7. Wearing a shirt without fastening all the buttons (except collar button) is not allowed.
8. All the students should wear only formal chappals or shoes. Slippers are not permitted.
9. **During placement and career related activities:** All the boys are expected to wear self-coloured pants with their shirt neatly tucked in with belt. They should wear Black or Brown colour Leather shoes only. Sports shoes are not permitted. All the girls are expected to wear formal dress. They should wear formal shoes only.



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
