The WEC-SVCE commemorated International Women's Day 2023 on March 8 through a variety of activities for the female faculty members and students. Around 400 people attended the events and a vast number of female staff members and female students competed from all the departments.

The events took place in the Multi-Purpose Hall of the SVCE campus. The inaugural ceremony began around 10.00 AM and Ms. Vasanthha, III year INT, welcomed the attendees. Ms. Sahana, a II year CSE student initiated the event with a song of prayer.

Dr. KR.Santha, Vice Principal, WEC chairperson, and Head of the department of EEE gave a speech about being proud to be a woman after welcoming everyone and introducing the event's chief guest, Dr. Rosy Fernando, the founder of Startup Solutions in Chennai.

Dr. Rosy Fernando interacted with the audiences and delivered speech intended to inspire them. Students actively participated throughout her highly interactive talk. The crux points of her empowering talk are:

- Emphasis on the development of personal skills in one's own areas of strength and interest.
- Suggestions on the practise of creating resumes on a regular basis beginning with their first academic year.
- Significance of technological advancement towards Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) and numerous creative entrepreneurial ideas in this direction.
- Discussion of a few case studies from her professional experience.

Following the inaugural event, the celebration began with a number of individual and team contests, such as Rangoli, Adaptune, Tug-of War, Treasure Hunt, Solo-vocals, cooking without fire, etc. to highlight the skills of them. Each event was well coordinated by the student and faculty in-charges and got a resounding response. The chief guest was

quite appreciative of the students' motivation to display the stalls which encourage entrepreneurship in them.

After the events, the valedictory session began at 3.00 PM with a special dance and music programme by the music club, SVCE to enthral the students' gathered. The WEC, SVCE Chairperson awarded the certificates and monetary awards to the champions of all the competitions.
