c) Details of the program :

NCC (Army) cadets of Sri Venkateswara College of Engineering, Sriperumbudur volunteered in the "POLIO VACCINATION CAMP" under the guidance of ANO Capt. Dr. A. Bhaskaran (NCC Coordinator) and CTO. Dr. M. Sukumar (NCC Army). 12 Cadets of NCC Army Wing, 9 Cadets of NCC Air Wing, and 3 Cadets of NCC Navy Wing volunteered in the camp and vaccinated to  $\approx$  400 children's.

Dr. M. Sukumar, Asst. Professor, Dept. Applied Physics, Care-Taker NCC Army Wing guided the cadets to give the polio drops to children who are travelling through the Toll Booth near Sri Venkateswara College of Engineering. The Nurse gave instructions on vaccination to the cadets. The cadets split into 3 groups and vaccinated the children below 5 and 5 years. The nails of the children were marked with indelible ink after vaccination.

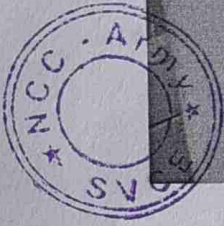


Fig. 2. Principal providing polio drops to the child

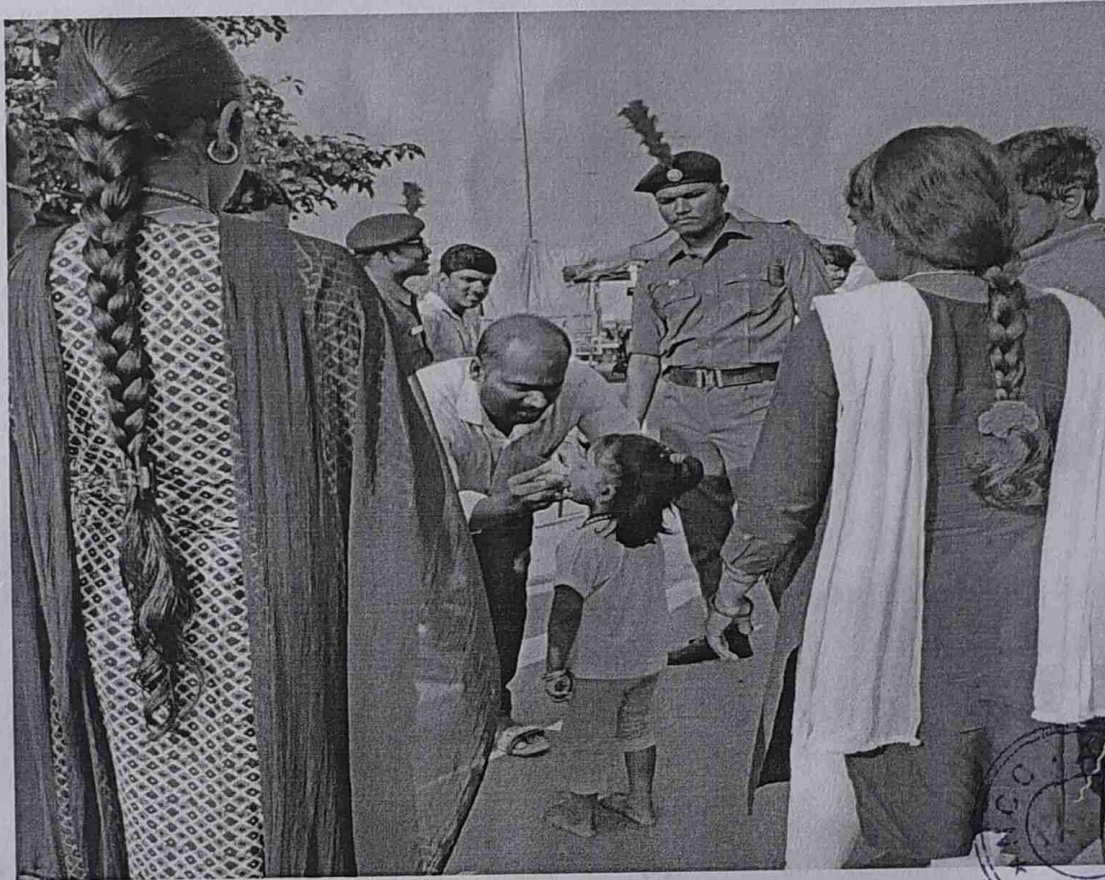


Fig. 4. CTO (NCC Army) providing polio drops to the child

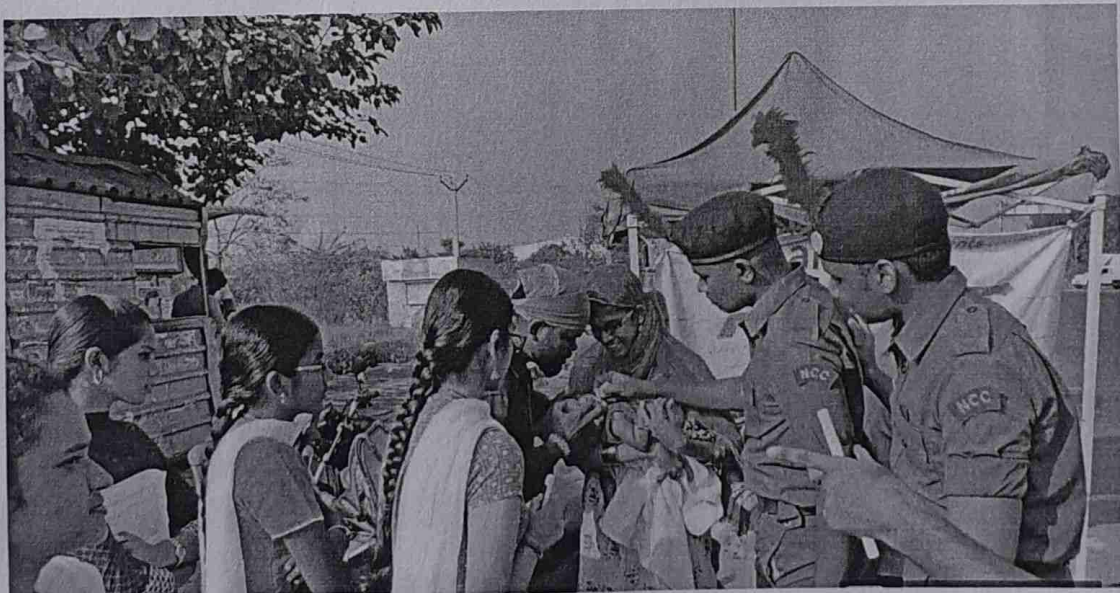


Fig. 5. NCC Army Wing Cadets vaccinating the child

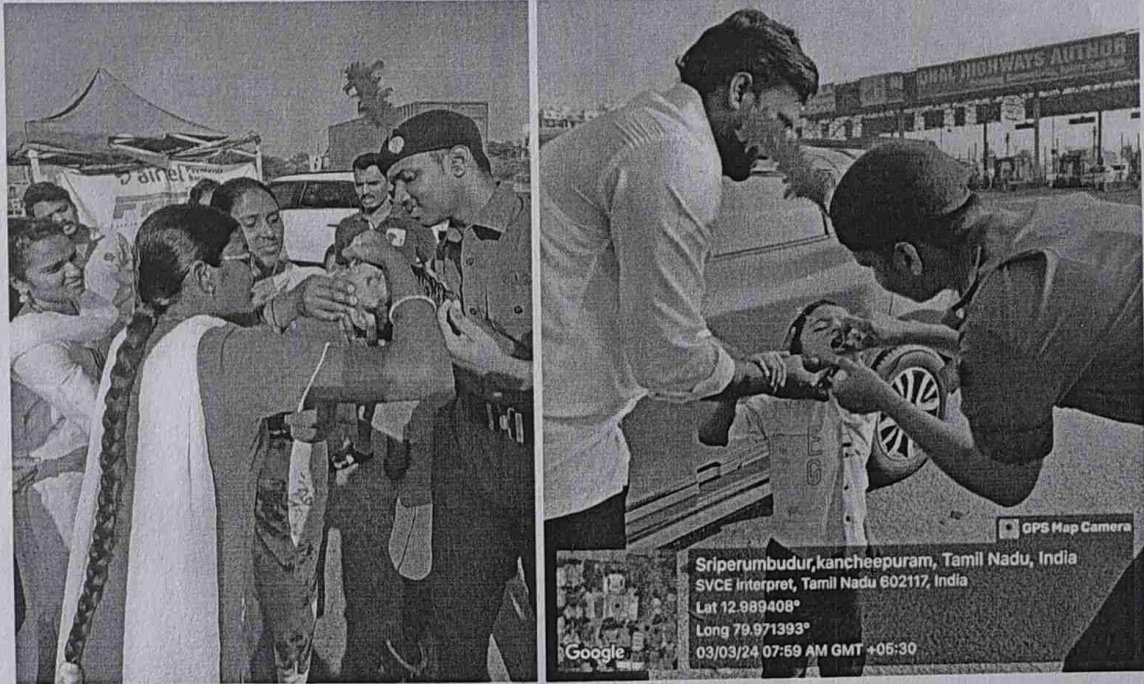


Fig. 6. NCC Army Wing Cadet providing polio drops to a child at Toll Booth

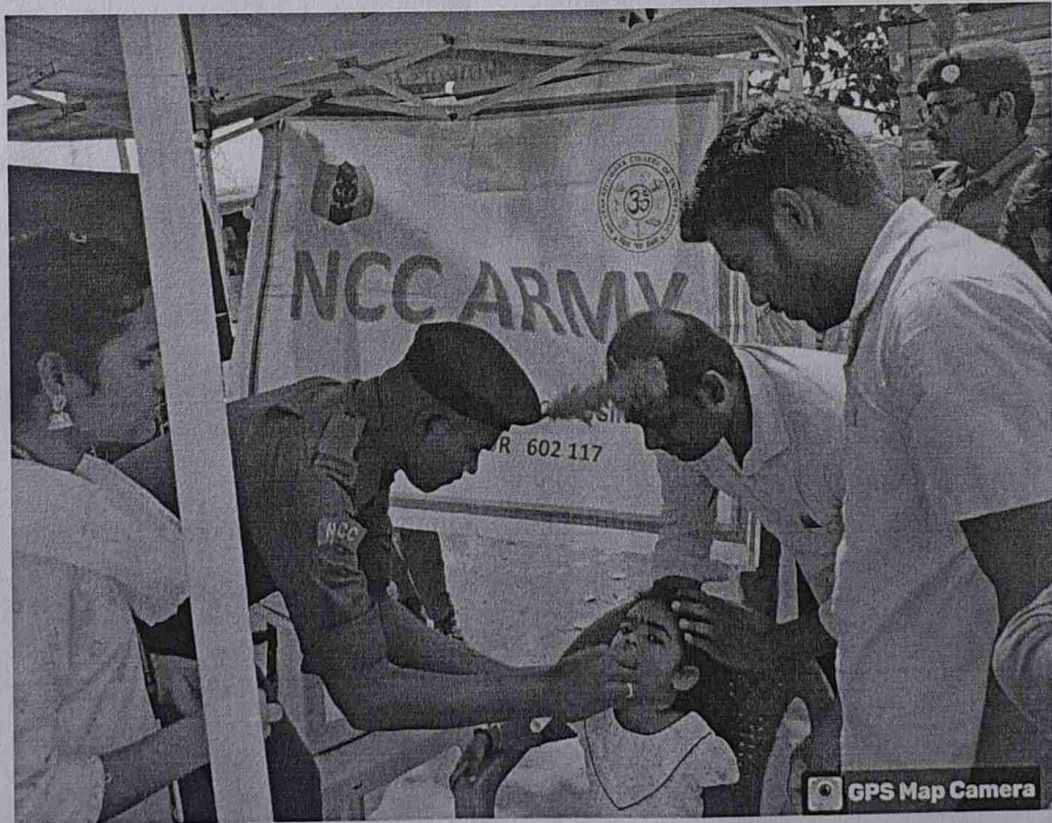


Fig. 7. NCC Army Wing Cadet vaccinating the child
